I recently met you at the IPU conference in Chile where we discussed our mutual friend Nadia Makram Ebid. I now have some questions on an issue, which you may be able to help me or perhaps direct me to the appropriate person to contact.

I am writing to inquire about Egyptair flight 990 that crashed in the Atlantic Ocean on October 31, 1999, and the subsequent investigation that was undertaken as per the request of the Egyptian Government.

Most recently an individual gave a presentation in my office suggesting that this crash was not an accident. While I am far from being an expert on aviation matters, the presentation was quite convincing.

I am writing to inquire if you are satisfied with the final report that was provided by the US National Transportation Safety Board and if the Egyptian Government considers this case closed.

Any information that you might be able to provide would be very much appreciated.
